



For the **International Seminar**, a registration of <u>Php 5,800</u> for Filipino attendees and \$120 for foreigners will be charged from each participant to cover the speakers' honoraria, 3 lunches, 6 snacks, seminar kit and certificates. A special fee of **Php 5, 200** may be offered to early registrants who will pay 2 weeks before the actual seminar. Accommodation is not included.

For the **National Seminars** a registration of <u>Php 3,500.00</u> will be charged from each participant to cover the expenses for the speaker's fees, 3 lunches for two days, snacks (6), seminar kit and certificates. A special fee of **Php 3,000** may be offered to early registrants who will pay at least 2 weeks before the seminar proper. Registration fee may be charged to local funds if available. Lodging is not included.
